COASTAL GASLINK PROJECT

Surerus Murphy Joint Venture is constructing two spreads of TC Energy's Coastal GasLink pipeline project, both near Chetwynd, B.C. Our spreads are northeast of Chetwynd, near Groundbirch, and south, parallel to the Sukunka River. Combined, the two spreads equate to 140 km of 48" pipe — spread 1 is 92 km long and Spread 2 is 48 km long. The project started in early 2019, and was completed in 2023 with cleanup following and finishing in late 2023. At its peak, this project employed over 800 people. The increased requirement for static winches is unique to this project due to the numerous steep slopes.
